Most beautiful Europa stamp 2017 – Online Competition

The results of the “Most beautiful Europa stamp 2017” online competition were presented at the PostEurop Plenary Assembly in Bucharest on 28 September 2017. The competition registered over 11,000 votes in total.



The first place gold winner of this competition was Turkey – PTT Turkish Post (see stamp). Silver went to Poland – Poczta Polska and bronze to Moldova – Posta Moldovei.

Most Beautiful Europa stamp 2017 – Jury Competition

In addition to the public competition, PostEurop also held its EUROPA Jury Competition at PostEurop’s Headquarters in June this year.



The winning stamp came from Finland–Posti with an illustration of a snow castle!

The second place was shared by Åland – Åland and Italy – Poste Italiane, and in third place we have Liechtenstein – Liechtensteinische Post.
